The Board of Supervisors of Fayette County, Iowa, met on Monday, April 23, 2018, at 9:00 o'clock a.m., at the Fayette County Supervisors' office.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairperson, and the roll was called showing the following Supervisors present and absent:

Present: Jeanine Tellin, Darrel Dolf and Janell Bradley

Absent: -None-

Motion was made by Bradley and seconded by Dolf to approve the current agenda. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

Motion was made by Dolf and seconded by Bradley to approve the minutes from the Monday, April 16, 2018 meeting. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

Motion was made by Bradley and seconded by Dolf to approve the agreement to provide Public Health & Homecare Services to the residents of Fayette County, Iowa with Local Public Health Services Contract and County Funds FY19. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

Motion was made by Dolf and seconded by Bradley to approve the First Judicial District Department of Correctional Services Contract to house Fayette County Jail prisoners at the West Union Residential Facility for Fiscal Year 2019. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

Motion was made by Bradley and seconded by Dolf to approve the Fayette County Conservation & Chauffeurs, Teamsters and Helpers Local Union No. 238 Contract. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

Motion was made by Dolf and seconded by Bradley to appoint Jed Siebrecht from Clermont, Iowa, to the Fayette County Conservation Board. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

Upon completion of 20 years with the FCCB and according to union contract, Dan Harrington will receive a \$0.05 increase in hourly wages. His new hourly rate will be \$17.41 beginning with the April 9th payroll.

Beginning April 16th, Milton Voss will be employed by the FCCB as campground host at Gouldsburg Park, a seasonal position. His hourly rate will be \$10.50 per hour, taken out of the conservation budget.

Beginning April 30th, Clarke Campbell will be employed by the FCCB as a seasonal employee with the parks division. His hourly rate will be \$9.00 per hour, taken out of the

conservation budget. Clarke will attend the safety training course on April 26 and receive pay for that day, prior to starting full time duties on April 30th.

Effective 4/9/2018 Ashley Kisner has been hired as a Temporary Part Time Detention Officer for the Fayette County Sheriff's Office. Ashley's wage will be \$14.51 per hour.

Effective 4/19/2018 Tami Robrock has been hired as a Temporary Part Time Cook for the Fayette County Sheriff's Office. Tami's wage will be \$14.25 per hour.
