The Board of Supervisors of Fayette County, Iowa, met on Monday, April 8, 2019 at 9:00 o'clock a.m., at the Fayette County Supervisors' office.

The roll was called showing the following Supervisors present and absent:

Motion was made by Tellin and seconded by Stanbrough to approve the current agenda. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

Motion was made by Tellin and seconded by Stanbrough to amend the agenda to include approving the updated Turkey River Recreational Corridor Bylaws. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

Motion was made by Stanbrough and seconded by Tellin to approve the minutes from the Monday, April 1, 2019 meeting. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

The Board met with Tim Cummings, Custodian, for an update.

The Board met with Mallory Hanson from Turkey River Recreational Corridor for a review of the bylaws.
