The Board of Supervisors of Fayette County, Iowa, met on Monday, January 28, 2019 at 9:00 o'clock a.m., at the Fayette County Supervisors' office.

The roll was called showing the following Supervisors present and absent:  
Present: Janell Bradley, Jeanine Tellin and Marty Stanbrough  
Absent: -None-

Motion was made by Tellin and seconded by Stanbrough to approve the current agenda. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

Motion was made by Stanbrough and seconded by Tellin to approve the minutes from the Monday, January 21, 2019 meeting. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

The Board met with Joel Fantz, County Engineer, for a Secondary Roads update.

Motion was made by Tellin and seconded by Stanbrough to approve the Snow Removal Assistance Program with County Conservation. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

Effective 01/13/2019, Blake Gamm will receive additional compensation per the Snow Removal Assistance Program with County Conservation at a rate of \$19.00 per hour.

Effective 01/27/2019, Troy Streif in the Roads Department has been promoted from Maintenance Employee II to Operator III. His wage will increase from \$20.96 per hour to \$21.14 per hour (\$20.99/hour base rate, plus \$0.15/hour longevity).

Effective 01/27/2019, Thomas Shea in the Roads Department has been promoted to Assistant Quarry Foreman. His wage will increase from \$20.96 per hour to \$21.46 per hour (\$21.31/hour base rate, plus \$0.15/hour longevity).

Motion was made by Stanbrough and seconded by Tellin to approve the Frey Bridge Construction Contract, FM-CO33(135)- - 55-33, to Jim Schroeder Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$936,529.85 and to authorize the Board Chairperson to sign all contract documents. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

Motion was made by Tellin and seconded by Stanbrough to approve the following license:

The application of Sam Schmitt Enterprises, Ltd., d/b/a Alpha Tavern for a 12 month Class C Liquor License with Sunday Sales and Outdoor Service for use in Eden Township was submitted and recommendation made that the license be granted. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

The Board had a conference call with Lisa Leuck, Library Director for the Elgin Public Library for an update regarding the libraries in Fayette County and also a budget request. The board agreed to the increase of 2% as was requested by the librarians.

The Board had a discussion regarding the City of West Union’s request to have Fayette County administer the City Energy District.

Following the discussion, the board decided it does not wish to take over the administration of the West Union Energy District.

The Board reviewed the proposed County budget.

Motion was made by Stanbrough and seconded by Tellin to set the Public Hearing for the local Fayette County Budget and the Public Hearing for the Amended County Budget as follows:

The matter of considering and filing the local budget for Fayette County, Iowa for the fiscal year July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020 was taken up. The Budget Hearing was set for 10:00 o’clock A.M., Tuesday, February 19, 2019 in the Supervisors’ office in the courthouse at West Union. The budget was ordered to be published in the Oelwein Daily Register, Fayette County Union, and the Elgin Echo.
