Motion was made by Dolf and seconded by Bradley to approve the final reading of Fayette County Ordinance #41 (Regulations Regarding Off-Road Utility Vehicles on Secondary Roads Ordinance). On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

The Board met with Joel Fantz, County Engineer, for a Secondary Roads update.

The Board had a discussion regarding window coverings for the Courthouse Window Project.

Motion was made by Bradley and seconded by Dolf to approve the First Judicial District Department of Correctional Services Contract to house Fayette County Jail prisoners at the West Union Residential Facility for Fiscal Year 2018. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

The Board had a conference call with Amy Reasner from Lynch Dallas. This was an exempt meeting under Iowa Code 20.17(3).
