The Road Department has hired Weller Clark of West Union as temporary seasonal help. The position will primarily be to fill in on the Road Department or Conservation team when other members are gone or when bigger crews are needed. In accordance with the Temporary Summer Help pay scale, he will begin at a starting wage of \$12.00 per hour.
