Motion was made by Dolf and seconded by Bradley to approve the waiver for the Frontier North Expansion. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

The Board met with Joel Fantz, County Engineer, for an update.

Motion was made by Bradley and seconded by Dolf to approve the Amendment #1.0 to the Secondary Road Construction Program. The amendment will add the replacement of the Frey Bridge due to its destruction by flood waters and will modify the W51 Pavement Rehab and Widening project due to the addition of a \$618,000 Federal and State Safety Grant. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

The Board went on a road trip to Prairie View to view some maintenance issues.
