The Board had a brief discussion regarding an assignment of a tax sale certificate on a mobile home.

At the recommendation of the County Auditor, a motion was made by Dolf and seconded by Tellin to raise the Election Workers pay to \$10 per hour and the Election Worker Chair to be at \$11 per hour. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

The Board met with Don Bright and Jamie Hackley for a discussion regarding putting a permanent marker at the pioneer cemetery at Prairie View with the names of all the deceased who are buried there.

The Board met with Marty Fisher, Sheriff, for a discussion regarding a land swap between Fayette County and the City of West Union.

Motion was made by Dolf and seconded by Tellin to set the date for the Public Hearing for the land swap between Fayette County and the City of West Union for Monday, October 1, 2018 at 9:15 a.m. at the Supervisor's office in the Courthouse. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

Motion was made by Dolf and seconded by Tellin to not allow additional entities outside of county government to post on the Fayette County website. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

The Board had a discussion regarding replacing the doors on the Courthouse parking lot garage. Bids will be taken.

The Board met with Jon Biederman, Fehr Graham, for an update on the Courthouse Parking Lot Project.

The Board met with Tim Cummings, Custodian, for a brief update.

The Board met with Don Doebel, who is requesting to use the courthouse lawn and the gazebo for Trunk or Treating.

Motion was made by Dolf and seconded by Tellin to allow Main Street West Union the use the courthouse lawn and the gazebo for Trunk or Treating on October 21, 2018 with a rain date of October 28, 2018. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

The Board had a discussion regarding a request for funding from Mobile Mama.

Motion was made by Dolf and seconded by Tellin to not provide funding for the Mobile Mama program at this time. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

The Board met with Joel Fantz, County Engineer, for a Secondary Roads update.

Effective September 17, 2018, Megan Robbins has been hired as a clerk in the Auditor's office. Her beginning wage will be \$43,000 per year.

The Board adjourned.
