The Board of Supervisors of Fayette County, Iowa, met on May 18, 2020 at 9:00 o'clock a.m., via Zoom.

The roll was called showing the following Supervisors present and absent:

Present: Jeanine Tellin, Janell Bradley and Marty Stanbrough.

Absent: -None-

Motion was made by Stanbrough and seconded by Bradley to approve the current agenda. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

Motion was made by Bradley and seconded by Stanbrough to approve the minutes from the Monday, May 11th, 2020 meeting. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

Motion was made by Stanbrough and seconded by Bradley to approve the updated Fayette County Pandemic Leave Policy. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

Motion was made by Bradley and seconded by Stanbrough to approve the Heartland Insurance renewal. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

Motion was made by Stanbrough and seconded by Bradley to open the Public Hearing at 9:31 a.m. for the purpose of hearing comments on the amending of the 2019/2020 operating budget adopted on March 11, 2019 and previously amended on March 9, 2020. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

The notice of the time and place of the budget amendment hearing was published in the Oelwein Register, Elgin Echo & the Fayette County Union on May 6, 2020. Four County Officials were present at the public hearing and two News Reporters via Zoom. There were no members of the general public. A brief summary of the budget amendment was given. No questions were asked.

At 9:32 a.m. a motion was made by Bradley and seconded by Stanbrough to close the public hearing. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

Motion was made by Stanbrough and seconded by Bradley to adopt the Fayette County budget amendment for the 2019-2020 budget as filed on April 27, 2020 and published on May 6, 2020. On roll call, Tellin, Bradley and Stanbrough all voted aye, none nay, and the following resolution was adopted.

Motion was made by Bradley and seconded by Stanbrough to approve the Response Technologies Centurion Armor Product Protection and Technical Support Plan at the same level we are at currently. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

Motion was made by Bradley and seconded by Stanbrough to approve the contract with Lynch Dallas for the Union and HR contracts. On roll call, all voted aye, none nay, and the motion was carried.

The Board had a discussion regarding the opening of the Courthouse. From today through May 29th, the courthouse doors will remain closed to the public but county officials will allow individuals to enter the building if they have a scheduled appointment at a county office. Effective June 1, 2020 the Courthouse will be opened to the public. Hand sanitizer and face coverings are strongly recommended during the visit.

The Board met with Joel Fantz, County Engineer, for a secondary roads update.

Effective 4/25/2020 Christopher Barren has been employed by the Fayette County Sheriff's Office as a Detention Officer for 3 years. Christopher's wage will increase to \$18.84 per hour.
